

Eastland Church of God League Policy 2020-2021 Season

We are preparing for a fun, full season of basketball and cheerleading with the understanding that these are different times than other years. We can't wait to have you back on our property playing basketball, cheering and learning about Jesus. Below, we have outlined a few of the new policies that will be implemented this season. We ask that you read through each section and sign the bottom portion. This needs to be on file before students can participate in the first practice.

Refund Policy:

This is the new policy regarding refunds for this year specifically if we have to shut down due to COVID:

Once uniforms are purchased by the players, a full refund will not be possible. If at that time you wish to not continue with the season, you will only be refunded the remainder of the season's registration which is \$13.

If you are a scholarship student, you will not be able to get a refund this year. This is because the amount you pay goes directly to the uniforms and the church pays the remainder of your uniform fee (which is the scholarship).

Mask Policy:

We have been following the school decisions, KDE and the governor's mandates about mask usage in sports. We will adhere to the KDE decision that all players, coaches, volunteers, parents and fans must wear masks at all times.

Players may take off their masks during the active part of practice (running, fundamentals, scrimmages, etc), but must wear it during the devotion, when not active, walking to the restroom, and when leaving the gym.

COVID Positive Policy:

This is a different experience for all of us with COVID. Normally, we may all have gone to work, school, practice, or even church sick. But in these unprecedented times, we are asking all Upward families, coaches and volunteers to partner with us in staying home when you are sick. If you are exhibiting any signs of COVID, or have been exposed, please stay home. Below you will find our COVID policy.

If a player tests positive for COVID, that team will not play for 10 days. The team they would be playing on game day would scrimmage themselves.

If a player's family member tests positive for COVID, the player will not play for 10 days. The team can continue to play.

*Additionally, the same would apply if the coach tests positive or someone in their family tests positive

Fan Attendance at Games Policy:

This year in order to social distance in the gym, we are asking that all Upward families limit who comes to watch the game to **4 people per player or family**. One idea would be to rotate who comes each week if extended family members like grandparents would like to attend. We know that this is not the norm for our Upward families and we still want you to have the opportunity to cheer on your players, but in as safe a way as possible.

Acknowledgement and Consent to Play:

I acknowledge the new policies and agree to adhere to them this season. I understand that were we to be shut down due to COVID after the uniforms are purchased that I will only receive a partial refund of \$13 or no refund (scholarship players). I understand the mask policy, COVID policy for positive cases, and fan attendance at games policy.
